



Attention Nobles of S.A.S.A

As you know, the 49th Annual Meeting of the South Atlantic Shrine Association (SASA) is September 15th - 17th, 2022 in Myrtle Beach, SC. *This Session will again offer us opportunities to help our hospitals.*

This year, as we did last year, Kosair Charities via Kosairs Shriners, is offering a Kosair / SASA Challenge Grant of up to \$100,000 to the Members of SASA that will benefit the S.A.S.A. supported hospitals.

Greenville, Dayton and Lexington Hospitals will split this donation equally.

The Temples of SASA and fellow Nobles need to raise \$100,000 to meet the Kosairs Charities Challenge

That means \$200,000, or more, will be awarded September 15 in the Business meeting.

➔ To make it fair, Temples will compete head-to-head using handicapping system based on temple membership to determine Platinum, Gold, and Silver Award Winners. And there will be a Special Award for the Temple with the largest Donation.

Scoring System

Temple Name	Temple Membership	Points Handicap	Donation (example)	Points
Red	5,000	1	\$5,000	5000
Blue	3,000	1.7	\$5,000	8333
Green	1,000	5	\$5,000	25000
Gold	500	10	\$5,000	50000

Determining Winning Temples

Temple with most members determine Baseline Number. Example Below.

- Temple Red: Handicap = Baseline, (5,000 members) divided by Temple Red members (5,000/5,000) = Handicap of (1)
- Temple Blue: Handicap = Baseline, (5,000) divided by Temple Red members (5,000/3,000) = Handicap of (1.7).
- Temple Green: Handicap = Baseline, (5,000) divided by Temple Red members (5,000/1,000) = Handicap of (5).
- Temple Gold: Handicap = Baseline, (5,000) divided by Temple Red members (5,000/500) = Handicap of (10).
- Points = Temple donation multiplied by temple Handicap = Temple Points total. Most Points Win
